Your selection will determine the purpose of each virtual card. Each incoming <b>transaction will be checked by AirPlus as to whether the service provider matches the merchant category</b> selected when the card was generated. If they do not match, the transaction will be declined.  <b>Please note:</b> Transaction type "Retail": this type is <u>only</u> usable for AirPlus Virtual Cards Procurement. For AirPlus Virtual Cards Classic and AirPlus Virtual Cards Travel Agency, the transaction type "Retail" cannot be chosen.
