

Here you can find information on the new IP address that you need to set up if you receive the data from AirPlus directly on your SFTP server.

AirPlus products are being moved to new systems step by step. During a transitional period, you will receive your electronic data from two different IT systems. In the future, we will provide the data for AirPlus Virtual Cards transactions to you in a separate file on your SFTP server. We will transmit these data via our new IP address, 193.254.30.133, Port 22.

You will continue to receive all other transaction data from the same IP address as before, 193.254.30.34.

Please set up this additional IP address for AirPlus and, where applicable, enable it in your firewall as well. Once you do this, you will be able to process your data as previously and receive the transaction and billing data for your AirPlus Virtual Cards. Please also be sure to add the new public SSH RSA key to your settings.

The new SSH RSA key is `iom_ebilling_ssh_sftp.pub`.

If you have already set this up, you don't need to do anything else. Starting at the time of the migration, you will receive your AirPlus Virtual Cards data via the new IP address.

Otherwise, please be sure to set up the new transmission channel right away.

We will send you another e-mail soon to let you know the exact date of the changeover.
